Major Actions and Decisions of the Board of Directors, July, 2010 Meeting

1. Watkins announced the death of a long time office employee, Miss "Sam" Allen. We will miss her.
2. Craig announced that annual elections are soon coming. Candidates need to announce their candidacy or interest in running for office. At this time, Craig, Grimes, Budd, Misner and Carroll will seek reelection. Specific details on the election are in this month's issue of the Muzzleblast. Baygents remarked that the Club's website does not have a large number of users to indicate interest in either the website or the Muzzleblast. Craig stated that the Muzzleblast was moved to the Website at the direction of the BOD. Those members who wanted a copy mailed home were told in previous mailed Muzzleblast issues to simply notify the Club Office.
3. Carter stated that a written report is not ready at this time. Craig reported that all Club property seemed to be accounted for and all financial records seemed to be in order.
4. Repair of the 15 yard range berm was discussed. In-house repair was estimated at \$23,000 plus or minus \$2,000, The BOD decided to get estimates from local contractors.
5. Erickson was tasked with trying to find a professional company that could do a sound and noise survey at our range. That type survey would be of use in the decisions involved with buying additional property.


**2010 Internal Audit Results
and Recommendations**

On June 17th, the Internal Audit committee conducted an audit of the past year, with a follow-up on June 22nd. Those in attendance the first evening were Randy Erickson, Treasurer, Bill Craig, Secretary, Braley Carroll, Lloyd Watkins, Sue Carter, Brenda Trickler, Business Manger, and GRPC general member Andrew Elstein. The follow-up meeting was a physical inventory of firearms and ammunition done by Braley Carroll and Bill Craig. The primary areas reviewed included the store operations, the general club financial operations, payroll, and the club asset inventory. No significant variances or discrepancies were found. During the audit several processes were reviewed and the following recommendations were made:

1. There were no irregularities found in the cash handling procedures. However, for control purposes, it is recommended that someone outside the process opens and reviews the bank statements and cancelled checks before forwarding them to the CPA for reconciliation. This will allow an unbiased set of eyes the opportunity to spot and question anything out of the ordinary. The Treasurer or President would be the ideal candidates for this added responsibility.
2. Random vendor files were pulled and payments were reviewed. Verification was made of sufficient invoice backup and appropriate approvals. For one vendor, Action Labor, receipts need to include more explanation as to the work completed. Given the nature of this service, the vendor demands more oversight. Invoices also should be marked more consistently as being reviewed by a Board member. No payments were found to be inappropriate.
3. A physical inventory of the GRPC owned firearms and ammunition was conducted on June 22nd. All matched Club inventory records. However, Ray Kerbs, the custodian, asked to be removed from the access list of authorized persons after the audit was completed. Reluctantly his request was so done. Thanks Ray for all the work and effort over so many years.

These are general recommendations as nothing appeared out of order and the results of the external audit in 2009 were positive.

WARNING TO ALL MEMBERS

Lloyd Watkins asked me, Bill Craig, to again have printed an abbreviated version of an article in a most recent Muzzleblast. This is due to some very serious safety violations and even a threat to one of our Range Safety Officers (RSO's). I strongly believe that the readers of this Muzzleblast are not the people causing the problems. However, we do need your help to document serious safety violations and abuse to our RSO's should you witness such actions. Frankly, we do not need this type people in our Club. We are presently in the process of severe disciplinary actions including a permanent revocation of membership.

There are two areas of concern that continue to arise at our Club ranges.

A. The most important is the fact that a few, just a few, members have been shooting high power rifles on the back section of the all purpose range. This is a major safety violation and is against the posted Club rules in that area. You are jeopardizing the rights of all of our Club members.

Let there be NO misunderstanding. If you are caught shooting high power center fire cartridges such as but not limited to the .30 caliber US carbine, 223 Remington (5.56 NATO), 7.62 x 39 mm Soviet, 308 Winchester in these all purpose range areas, you will face legal action and/or loss of Club membership. If in doubt as to what or where you can shoot, contact a Range Safety Officer before firing.

B. The second area of concern is the increase of incident reports which report members who are arguing with our Range Safety Officers (RSO's) after being corrected for a Club rule or safety violation. The RSO's have full authority at the ranges to enforce rules and check membership badges. They have the authority to tell major violators of safety or Club rules to leave the range. Time permitting, they are also a source of information and help to Club members. With the noise of gunshots and decreased hearing through ear protectors, they generally have to yell or talk loudly to be heard. Please cooperate with the RSO's. Serious safety or bad conduct will result in disciplinary action from the BOD. Conversely, members have the right to write an incident report on an RSO's behavior which is also taken seriously by Club management. The best rule is this. Obey the RSO's at the time and do not argue or give them a hard time. You can grieve later, make complaints with an incident report or make a verbal complaint to any Club officer or BOD member.

For all you other members who pay your dues, enjoy the Club and follow rules, and are not in the above two groups, THANKS AGAIN!

**ABSENTEE BALLOT
INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Absentee ballots may be completed at the Club office. Club members will write or mark their choices on the ballot, to include write in candidates. The ballot will be folded to insure privacy and placed in a plain white envelope supplied by Club office personnel. The Club office person receiving the sealed ballot will verify the Club member active status. The words "Absentee Ballot" will be written on the front of the envelope. On the backside of the envelope will be written the printed name and signature of the Club member on one side of the flap and the printed name and signature of the Club employee of Club official receiving the ballot will be on the opposite side of the sealed flap. These ballots will be placed in the ballot box and secured until the elections.

2. Absentee ballots may be mailed to the Club.

- a. Blank ballots are printed in the Muzzleblast and are online at our web site.
- b. Blank ballots are available in the Club Office.
- c. Blank ballots may be mailed to Club members upon request to Club office personnel.

The Club member will write or mark his/her choices as well as the write-in candidates (if any) on the ballot. The club member will print his/her name and sign his/her signature on the ballot. The signature, however, must be verified by a Public Notary with the Notary's name and seal on the ballot. The Club member will mail the ballot to the Club to the attention of the Club's Secretary with the words "ABSENTEE BALLOT" plainly written on the face of the mailed envelope.

3. Regular printed ballots will be on hand at the annual election on 30 October, 2010.
